#### Good-to-know:

- Low/Medium/High means 10s/100s/1000s kgs carbon dioxide (equivalent). We will not be
  testing this part. It just shows us that you have a relative understanding of the carbon impact
  of different actions, as well as helping us to estimate the overall carbon reduction from CL
  pledges.
- There is no reduction too big or too small. As long as you are using <u>your power</u> to make the <u>largest reduction</u> you can, that is what Carbon Literacy is about.
- If in doubt...explain, explain, explain! Our certification team only see this form, so we do not know anything beyond what you write. If you are unsure if what you have written will pass, help us understand your line of thought by writing it down.
